

Business Administration Minor

The Business Administration minor provides a general foundation of business knowledge, beneficial for all students. It is available to non-business majors or those business majors who are not required to complete the "business core" courses (Health Administration, General Economics, or International Economics).

In addition, the Business Administration minor is a way for non-business majors, who are interested in pursuing a Masters of Business Administration (MBA), to complete most of the required MBA foundation equivalent courses.

Requirements for the minor in Business Administration:

Macroeconomics	ECO 2013 (Pre: 30 credits)
Microeconomics	ECO 2023 (Pre: 30 credits)
Mgmt & Organizational Behavior	MAN 3025 (Pre: 60 credits)
Marketing Management	MAR 3023 (Pre: ECO 2013 & 2023, and 60 credits)
Financial Management	FIN 3403 (Pre: ACG 2021 & 2071, and 60 credits)

Students must complete a minimum of 6 credits of the upper-division minor coursework (3000+) at FAU. Minor courses cannot be used for any other business major or business core requirements. They may be used as business electives. All minor courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
