

## Electronic Commerce Minor

The Electronic Commerce Minor emphasizes an interdisciplinary business study of electronic commerce and the role of the Internet in business.

Due to the requirement of the Business Core, this minor is usually not practical for General Economics, International Economics or Health Administration majors. Courses used for the minor cannot count toward any College of Business major or core requirements except as business electives. A minimum of 6 credits must be taken in residence at FAU. The acknowledgement of the minor is official upon successful completion of a College of Business degree program.

In addition to the Business Core, students are required to complete the following three courses with a grade of "C" or better.
