

## Hospitality Management Minor

The Hospitality Management minor is offered by the Department of Industry Studies. The minor is designed for both business and non-business majors. Students must receive a "C" or better in all minor courses and must complete a minimum of 6 credits of upper-division coursework at FAU.

This minor is designed for majors from other colleges or business majors not required to complete the business core (Health Administration, General Economics, and International Economics) who want to pursue a career in the hospitality industry.
